How to Secure a Teaching Job

International Panel Presentation

Panelists:

- **Steve Otterson**, Relocation Specialist, Leading Out (New Zealand)
Steven Otterson (Steve-O) is an American teacher currently living and teaching in Minnesota. Steve was introduced to international education when he completed his student teaching while living in New Zealand. Several years later, Steve joined Leading Out for a year of teaching in Australia, which was one of the best years of his life. Steve is dedicated to providing expert advice for American teachers looking to teach in Australia or New Zealand.
- **Grace McCabe**, Pastoral Manager, Internationella Engelska Skolan (Sweden)
Grace McCabe graduated from Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario and was recruited by the International English School in Länna, Sweden in 2019. Grace taught Year 4 math and science at the beginning of her career, but was soon after given middle-level leadership opportunities in the area of pastoral care and mentorship. After teaching for three years, Grace joined the leadership team of the school and now works 100% as the school's pastoral manager, helping coach teachers and establish
